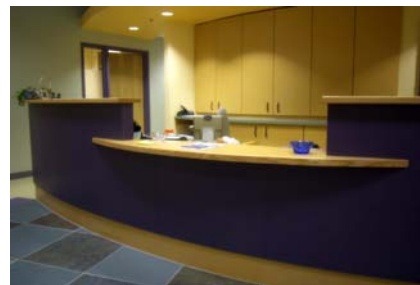
The work at the IWK Health Care Centre – Children’s Site consists of a number of projects ranging from approximately \$500,000 to over \$17 million dollars as part of their overall \$48 million construction budget. The work at the IWK Health Centre is comprised of the installation and fit-up of Research offices, installation of a new power back-up system, laboratories, expansion of operating theatres and the addition of three new additional floors on the existing building. Two floors for patient care, one floor for mechanical and storage. The work includes the redevelopment of existing paediatric spaces that will take place over the next 29 months. A new mixed use facility and playroom area will be constructed adjacent to the children’s wing.

All work is taking place within an operating hospital and infection control measures are in place to protect staff visitors and patients of the hospital. Planning and careful coordination of construction activities is a pivotal item for the successful completion of this project.
