Grading, drainage and granular base construction of some 2.8 km of expressway including interchange ramps and Mud Street extension to Stone Church Road. Escarpment bridge construction and the crushing of excavated rock into granulars are included in this contract.

Work was done in compliance with the City of Hamilton Environmental Protection Plan. In addition to this, due to the presence of a 16" pipeline which crosses the proposed expressway, any blasting and pile driving was completed in compliance with the Trans-Northern Pipeline Guidelines and Vibration Control Procedures.
